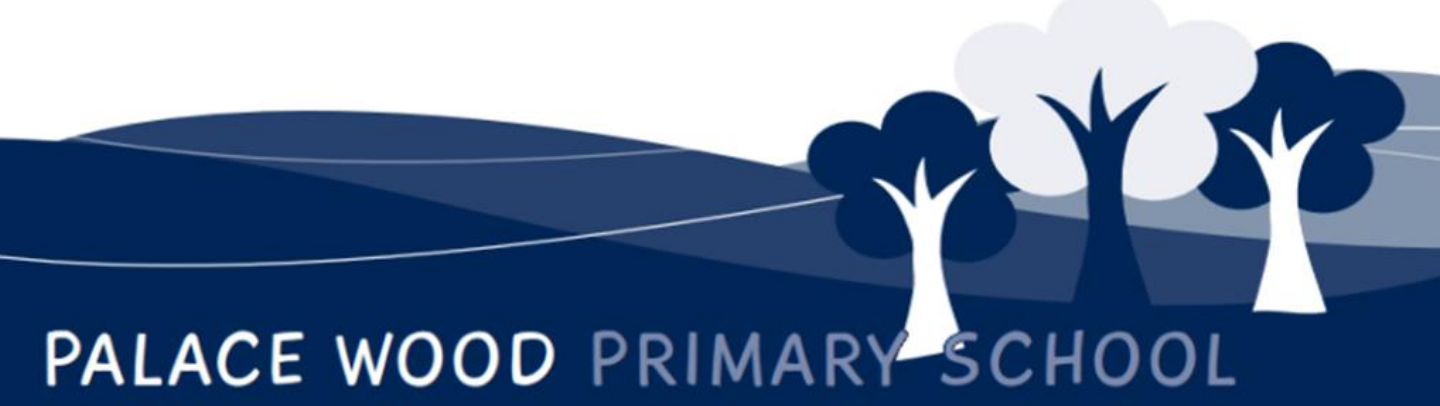

This week in Year 1 we have been learning about subtraction. The children worked around a carousel of practical activities to consolidate their understanding of subtraction.

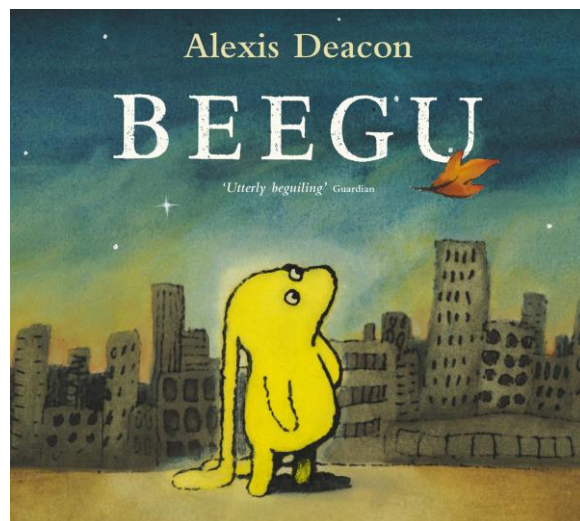

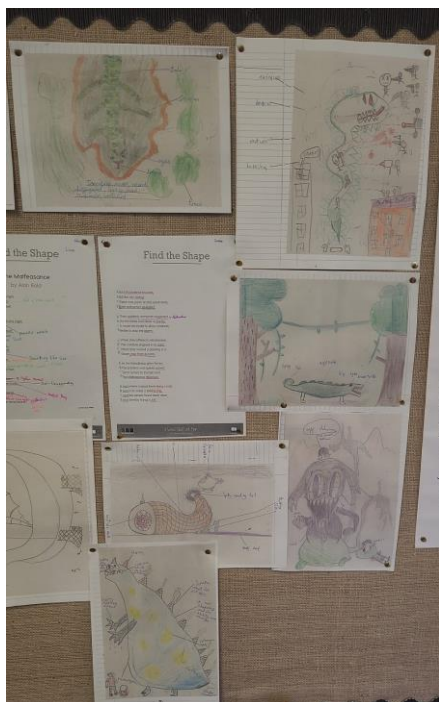

This week we have been studying the poem 'The Malfeasance' in English. We have been looking at the structure of the poem and have drawn the beast from the description.



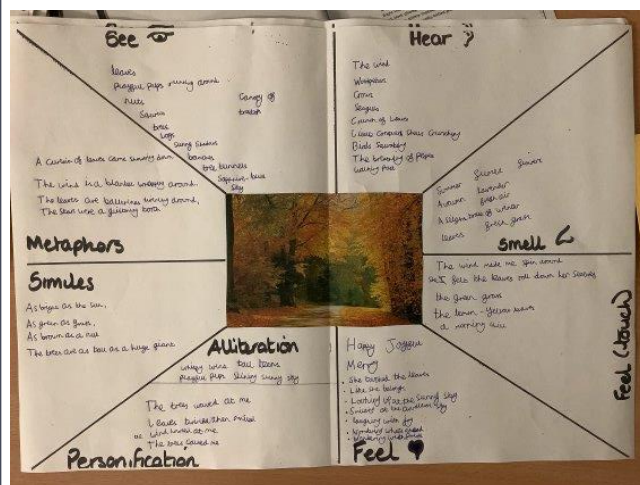
