KEY MESSAGES

Home Learning:

- **'ATOM Learning'** is set every Friday and is expected to be completed by the following Friday.

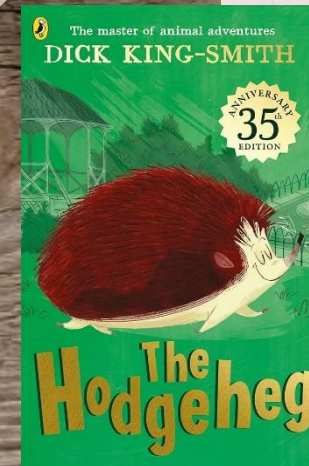

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Art
