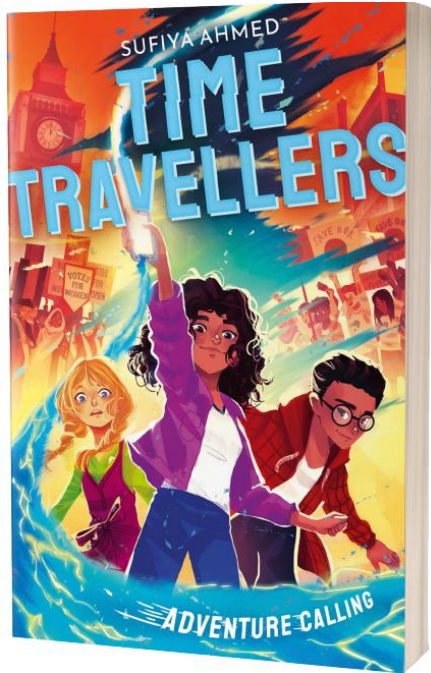




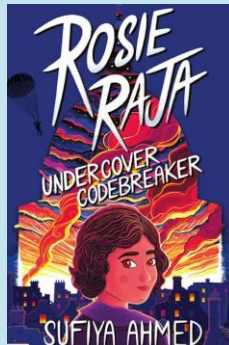
# Year 5 – Term 5 – Book Warmer

## Time Travellers – Adventure Calling by Sufiya Ahmed

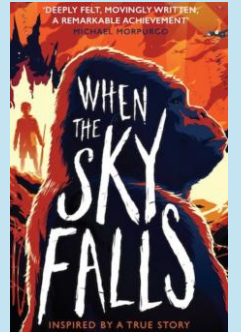
